Archery GB / WA:

All entrants must be members of Archery GB (GNAS) or a WA associated organisation. Archers **MUST** show their current membership cards at registration. If this is not provided you will not be able to shoot the competition.

Dress:

Archery GB dress regulation (Rule 307) or Club colours.

Photography:

Any person wishing to take photographs **MUST** complete a photography registration form on the day of the competition.

Drug testing:

Record status shoots are liable to drug testing, competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result for an illegal substance.

Juniors:

Junior entrants will shoot as adults as this is a Senior tournament.
Parents/guardians of junior archers must sign the entry/consent form to signify consent to their child being drug tested if approached. All juniors under the age of 18 must be supervised.

Club Teams:

Clubs are encouraged to compete for the Club Championship Trophy. Teams will consist of four archers, representing at least three of the four bow styles (LB/BB/RC/CUL), and must include at least one archer of each sex. Clubs may enter more than one team (e.g. club A/B/C). Team members must be identified before shooting commences (names to be finalised when target list is published and details sent in advance to the Tournament Organiser and no later than Saturday 10th January).

GDPR:

When you enter competitions, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors. For example, target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
