## Entries

Entries open: Sunday the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2026 at 19:00pm.

Deadline for amendments to the target list: Wednesday the 13<sup>th</sup> of May 2026 at 19:00pm.

## Cost of Entry

£36 per archer for the weekend. Single-day tickets are not available for this event.

## Equipment Inspection Time

*This is the time you should be ready to present your equipment, ready to shoot, to the judges.*

**Saturday** Equipment inspection begins at 8:00am.

**Sunday** (For those who did not attend on Saturday) equipment inspection begins at 9:45am.

## Registration

Registration will be during inspection. Valid AGB and student cards must be shown; physical or electronic (either must show the archer's name).

## Assembly

Assembly begins immediately after inspection ends.

## Judges

Chair of Judges (CoJ): Kieran Dexter

Judges: Sarah Dickinson, Louise Smith, John Fell, other judges TBC.

## Shooting Sequence & Timing

2 details of 2 archers per boss. Timing method 2. World Archery timing system.

Saturday: 30 seconds per arrow. Sunday: 40 seconds per arrow.

## Dress Code

AGB Rule 307 applies. Archers should wear club colours. Blue denim and camo are NOT permitted. Archers who do not comply will be asked to change clothes or cease shooting.

## Photography

In line with the recommendations in the AGB safeguarding policies, anybody taking pictures is required to provide their details in the google form accessible on the IANSEO results page.

## Drugs Testing

Competitors may be approached at random and must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result.

## Scoring

Scoring will be double scoring, with one paper scoresheet and one electronic PDA.

## Music

The organisers may play music throughout the entire event.

### Round

**Saturday** – Ranking Round (WA720) followed by individual Head-To-Head.

**Sunday** – WA900 (60m).

### Target Face Format

#### Saturday

Specific ranking rounds are copied from the BUCS ARC 2.2.1, reproduced here:

- Experienced Recurve and Longbow: 70m, 122cm.
- Novice Recurve and Longbow: 60m, 122cm.
- Experienced and Novice Barebow: 50m, 122cm.
- Experienced and Novice Compound: 50m, 80cm 6-ring.

#### Sunday

Full 122cm face for all divisions.

### Qualification to head-to-heads

The number of archers that qualify for the head-to-heads will be dependent on the number of entries per category and will be announced on the day. Divisions may be merged in order to create meaningful competition. Archers are not guaranteed to win a spot in the H2Hs.

### Event Format

Event formats may be changed on the day due to unforeseen circumstances.

### Medals

#### Head-To-Head

For the H2H, the three highest ranking archers in each division will receive medals.

#### NEUAL Outdoor Championships

Calculated from the highest combined score of archers shooting in their required division for the 720 ranking round and WA900.

#### *Individual events.*

According to entries, the top three archers in each division will receive a medal.

#### *Team events.*

Medals will be awarded for the three highest ranked teams (no nomination required):

Open Team (4; non-compound).

Un sighted Team (3; barebow/longbow).

Novice Team (3; novices, non-compound).

Mixed Team (1 compound + 1 recurve + 1 barebow)

### Awards ceremony

The awards ceremony for both sessions will take place at the end of the second session. You *must* be present to collect your medal on the day or ask a friend to collect your medal for you. At the end of the event, unawarded medals are prepared for the next event.

### **Assistance**

It is the responsibility of the archer and club captain to ensure that the organisers are aware of any special requirements a participant may have.

If the archer requires an agent, it is the archer's responsibility to provide this. If you are unable to organise an agent, please contact the tournament organiser before the event. The tournament organiser will not be able to provide an agent if it is only requested on the day.

### **Parking**

Limited parking is available onsite. Please give due consideration for spaces reserved for people with limited mobility. Consider carsharing to reduce emissions and travel cost.

### **Eligibility**

NEUAL events are primarily "closed events", exclusively for student archers. Entry will first be opened to students. If you book a student ticket you may be asked to provide evidence that you are a student. If you cannot satisfy the tournament organiser that you are a current student your entry may be cancelled without appeal.

### **Entry Information**

We recommend that captains and archers log into their accounts ahead of the opening date to ensure details of all archers are up to date, and that membership is valid.

All entries are to be submitted and paid for via Sport 80. A waiting list will open as soon as the event is filled. If a space opens up for you, you will be sent a link to accept and pay for your space. You will have 48 hours to do so before your space is offered to the next archer on the list.

### **Cancellations and refunds**

No refunds will be made unless extenuating circumstances can be demonstrated. Refunds will be made to the original payment method. The Sport 80 processing fee (4.8%) and Stripe processing fee (1.5% +20p) cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

### **Data collection**

NEUAL has a lawful basis to process user data. We have a legitimate interest in collecting, using, and sharing archers' data with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors, clubs, counties, regional, and national bodies. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers. These include your name, gender (AGAB and GI), bow style, date of birth, round, disability information, email address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any AGB-assigned codes for this information.

### **Use of likeness**

Please note that filming and photography will be taking place for posterity and promotional purposes. The pictures made are likely to appear online. If you would prefer not to be photographed, please let the photographers know.

### **Smoking and vaping**

No smoking or vaping is allowed anywhere on the field of play. For information on the permitted smoking locations, please contact the tournament organiser on arrival.

### Conduct

NEUAL strives to have a welcoming and friendly atmosphere at all levels of competition, and for everyone to leave having enjoyed their day's competition. We welcome encouragement and cheering in support of athletes, in a respectful sporting manner.

Examples of poor sporting manner include the purposeful wrong calling of arrows, and shouting loudly when an opponent is at full draw.

If you feel anyone is behaving in an inappropriate manner, inform either the chair of judges (CoJ), or the tournament organiser (TO). Both the CoJ and TO are empowered to ask people to change their behaviour or leave the venue.

### WA Target Awards

This event is eligible for WA Target awards. If you meet the criteria for a WA Target Award Badge on either day, please see the Tournament Organiser on that same day to fill in the paperwork.
