Assembly and Practice	Morning session: Assembly 8.45am followed by 2 ends of official practice Shooting will commence straight after practice Afternoon session: Head to Head matches

Rounds	WA70m/60m/50m  Under 18s – 60m recurve and longbows and 50m compound and barebow  Under 21s and Over 50s are welcome to take part but there are no separate categories at present but this may be reconsidered if numbers are sufficient.  Timing - 6 arrows in 4 minutes. Recurve and Longbow archers will shoot at 70m on a 122cm face Compound archers will shoot at 50m on individual 6 zone faces and Barebow archers will shoot at 50m on a 122cm face.

Entries	All entrants must be members of Archery GB (GNAS) or a WA associated organisation. Entrants will be asked to produce their membership cards at registration.  Entries will be available via ClubEvent
Closing Date	15 <sup>th</sup> May 2026. Refunds will not be given after the closing date. If eligible for a refund, entry fees paid online will be minus the surcharge.
Arrows	The venue is a school field and all arrows <b>MUST</b> be found. If you are using all carbon arrows, you must let the Tournament Organisers know in advance and present your arrows on arrival at the competition.
Juniors	Under 18s must always be accompanied by a member of their household who is over 18 and therefore assuming parental responsibility
First Aid	First aid kits will NOT be available for minor injuries, please ensure you have any items you feel are essential with you on the day.
Rules of Shooting	The competition will be shot to World Archery Rules
Dress Code	Only clothing in accordance with Rule 307 GNAS rules of shooting will be permitted
Awards	All awards are subject to the number of entries in each bow style.
Car Parking	Ample free car parking on site. <b>Please note there is strictly no camping allowed on site.</b>
Liability	Llantarnam Archery Club or Rougemont School will not accept liability for any loss or damage to any person or equipment during this event, for any reason whatsoever
Photography	Anyone wishing to take photographs should register their details with the organiser on arrival
Smoking	Smoking including E cigarettes will only be permitted behind the tent line
Drug testing	Record Status tournaments will be liable for drug testing, and any competitors approached to give samples must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result. Cadets must have a Parent/Guardian sign the entry form to signify consent to their child being tested, if approached
