## Events making up the Summer Series

The summer series will be contested over four competitions in the summer months.

- Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> April- World Record Status WA70/60/50/40/30 + Individual Head 2 Heads
- Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May- World Record Status WA70/60/50/40/30 + Mixed Teams
- Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> June- UK Record Status WA900 + AGB 900
- Date TBC- World Record Status Double 720

The Summer Series will use bow styles and not consider age group or gender. Archers who do not shot the correct distance for their bow style and age group will be entered into a 'Fun Shoot' and will be ineligible for records.

## Points System

Points will be issued for each of the stages listed in the table previous. Points will be based on Distance. Therefore, in the Recurve Division for example 3 sets of archers could obtain the maximum points if they have finished at the top of their distances.

Points are awarded on position as below.

1<sup>st</sup> Place- 25 Points

2<sup>nd</sup> Place- 22 Points

3<sup>rd</sup> Place- 20 Points

4<sup>th</sup> Place- 18 Points

5<sup>th</sup> Place – 16 Points

6<sup>th</sup> Place- 14 Points

7<sup>th</sup> Place- 13 Points

8<sup>th</sup> Place- 12 Points

9<sup>th</sup> Place- 11 Points

10<sup>th</sup> Place- 10 Points

11<sup>th</sup> Place- 9 Points

12<sup>th</sup> Place – 8 Points

13<sup>th</sup> Place- 7 Points

14<sup>th</sup> Place- 6 Points

15<sup>th</sup> Place- 5 Points

16<sup>th</sup> Place- 4 Points

17<sup>th</sup> Place- 3 Points

18<sup>th</sup> Place- 2 Points

19<sup>th</sup> Place- 1 Point
