Points System

Points will be issued for each of the stages listed in the table previous. Points will be based on category. You must shoot the correct distance for your age group to receive four points.

Points are awarded on position as below.

Entries to the events.

Each of the stages will have a separate entry form. Entry forms are an application to compete. The host club of each event reserves the right to refuse any entry to the competition. Archers entering the competition will accept this provision and understand if their entry has been rejected.

Finals

Should an archer complete three out of the four stages they will qualify for the finals. This is strictly invitational only. The morning will consist of a round robin format of individual head 2 head matches. Archers are responsible for being at the correct target for the start of their match, should an archer not be present they will be deemed to have forfeited the match. There will be a short break taken mid way through the match play to allow archers a rest and make use of the toilet facilities. After lunch archers who are 1st and 2nd after the round robin will progress to the gold medal match, archers who are 3rd and 4th after the round robin will progress to the bronze medal match. Medal matches will be conducted on a finals field, archers will have access to the practice field 30mins prior to their match. Archers should report

to the call room area 10mins prior to the start of their match. The finals field will be shot using alternative shooting formats.
