WA25; 60 arrows at 25 meters on a 60cm face.

Compound archers shoot at three-spot faces, scoring ten on the inner ten-zone ring.

Archery GB

It is a condition of your entry that you are a member of Archery GB and we may ask you for your membership card when you book in.

Archery GB Policy Update (effective October 2025)

This competition is Archery GB sanctioned with World Record Status, and therefore the latest Archery GB ruleset applies. In summary, the updated policy defines two competition categories:

- Female category: for participants recorded female at birth
- Open category: open to all archers, including those recorded male at birth, those recorded female at birth, and those identifying as transgender or non-binary.

Equipment check

As this is a World Record Status event, your equipment must be inspected before the session can start. Please be prepared to arrive a little earlier so the start of the shoot is not delayed.

Bosses

All archers will be shooting at 'Tenzon' layered foam bosses.

Timings

Archers will shoot three arrows in two minutes and timing will be by the Chronotir visual and audible timing system



Dress code

As this is world record status shoot dress regulations in accordance with Archery GB rule 307 apply. Please don't turn up in blue denim as you will not be allowed to shoot.

Drug testing

Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or guardians of junior competitors must confirm that they are willing to be tested if required.

Disabilities

Disabled spaces are available at the front of the building and

also adjacent to the disabled entrance, which is to the right of the entrance ramp. Please let us know if you have any specific requirements.
