

Photography: Any person wishing to take photographs **MUST** complete the photography registration form before the start of the competition.

Drug testing: Record status shoots are liable to drug testing, competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result for an illegal substance. Archers' parent or guardian must sign the entry form to signify their consent.

Attendance: In the event that the tournament is poorly subscribed, the organiser reserves the right to offer vacant slots to seniors wishing to shoot (unrewarded) for a nominal fee.

GDPR: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors. For example, target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
