<b>Event Format</b>	There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details. Compounds will be using 40cm, Triple Face. All others will be using 40cm, Full Size Face. Shooting will be in timed 3 arrow ends.  Only Single Rounds will be considered initially but to register an interest in a Double Round contact the TO. Scoring will be using 2 score sheets. We also reserve the possibility of using a lanseo phone App. instead of 1 sheet.
<b>Individual Awards</b>	Awards will be presented per gender, bow style and age group for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd if there are three archers for the group, for the single round. Your first round is the round that counts for Single awards.
<b>Dress Code</b>	Competitors must conform to AGB Rules of Shooting. For dress regulations (Rule 307). Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentation.

<b>Drug Testing</b>	All archers competing in record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply, if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. By signing to enter the tournament parents/ legal guardians are giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if appropriate.
<b>Refreshments</b>	Hot drinks and some snacks may be available on the day (to be confirmed). Please bring your own mug.
<b>Photography</b>	In line with Archery GB policy, anyone wishing to take video or photographs during the event must register their details with Tournament Organiser. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed, they should notify the Tournament Organiser. The organisers reserve the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by these conditions.
<b>Disabled Archers Please State your Needs</b>	Are you able to move on and off the Line in the time allowed? Are you able to collect your arrows? If you have any issues please discuss your specific requirement with the Tournament Organiser. It would be appreciated if archers could provide their own agent where possible.
<b>Able Bodied Archers</b>	Please indicate if you are not prepared to collect and score arrows for disabled archers.
<b>Eligible Participants.</b>	Only members and affiliated members of Archery GB (GNAS) or WA (FITA) associated organisations are permitted to shoot at this tournament. Competitors will be asked to produce membership cards before registration. All juniors must be supervised by a parent/legal guardian at all times.
<b>Disclaimer</b>	Neither RJD Archers, Glamorgan Archery Association or Llantrisant Leisure Centre can accept liability for loss or damage to person or equipment, however caused.
<b>GDPR</b>	When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors. For example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), Competition (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
