Method of Entry

Captains submit teams to the Tournament Organiser before the event date.

Round

Team head-to-heads.

Target Face Format

Recurve H2H: hit/miss 60mm gold spots.

Barebow H2H: hit/miss 60mm gold spots.

Compound H2H: hit/miss 40mm gold spots.

Traditional H2H: 60cm triple spot

Shooting Sequence & Timing

H2H: Matches between three teams. Each archer has 20 seconds to shoot each arrow. 10 ends cumulative scoring. Each archer on a team must shoot an equal number of arrows.

Judges

Chair of Judges (CoJ): Philip Taylor

Drugs Testing

Competitors may be approached at random and must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Dress Code

AGB Rule 307 applies. Archers should wear club shirts or Christie shirts. Blue denim and camo are NOT permitted. Archers who do not comply will be asked to change clothes or cease shooting.

Photography

In line with the recommendations in the AGB safeguarding policies, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register on arrival by scanning the QR code provided.

Inspection time

Hall opens 11am.

Inspection begins 11am.

Registration will be during inspection. Assembly begins immediately after inspection.

Scoring

Scoring will be double scoring, with one paper scoresheet and one electronic PDA.

Events

There will be 4 events in Christie.

Recurve Team - Consisting of 3 Recurve archers

Barebow Team - Consisting of 3 Barebow Archers

Compound Team - Consisting of 2 Compound Archers

Traditional Team - Consisting of 2 archers of any of the following bowstyles:

- Longbow (AGB)
- Asiatic (AGB)
- Any bowstyles that are not classified as longbow or asiatic, but fall under the World Archery Traditional Division

Event Format

Archers will shoot in teams of 2 or 3 depending on category, with 1 team member on the line at once. Event formats may be changed on the day due to unforeseen circumstances.

Results

Live results and final results book will be uploaded to IANSEO.

Awards ceremony

The winning team from each event will score 3 points towards the university squad, 2 points for 2nd and 1 point for 3rd. Medals will be awarded to the university with the highest total points. Ties will be resolved by total cumulative score across all events.

Music

The organisers may play music throughout the entire event.

Cheering/noises.

Cheering and similar, potentially loud noises are actively encouraged during shooting. Making any sounds which, in the opinion of the CoJ or TO, are made to deliberately throw an archer at full draw (e.g., using the word "click" or making a similar sound) is grounds for immediate disqualification.

Eligibility

This event is for archers who are part of Liverpool, Manchester and Leeds university only. All archers attending must be eligible for BUCS in order to be eligible for Christie. Archers must be able to show proof of Archery GB membership on request, including county and regional affiliation.

Assistance

It is the responsibility of the individual archer and club captain to ensure that the organisers are aware of any special requirements a participant may have. If you require an agent, it is the archer's responsibility to provide this. If you are unable to organise an agent, please contact the tournament organiser.

Data collection

In accordance with GDPR, Christie has a lawful basis to process user data. We have a legitimate interest in collecting, using, and sharing archers' data with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors, clubs, counties, regional, and national bodies. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers. These include your name, gender (AGAB and GI), bow style, date of birth, round, disability information, email address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any AGB-assigned codes for this information.

Use of likeness

Please note that filming and photography will be taking place for posterity and promotional purposes. The pictures made are likely to appear online. If you would prefer not to be photographed, please let the photographers know.

Smoking and vaping

No smoking or vaping is allowed inside the building. For information on the permitted smoking locations, please contact the sports centre information desk on arrival.

Parking

Conduct

Christie strives to have a welcoming and friendly atmosphere at all levels of competition, and for everyone to leave having enjoyed their day's competition. We welcome encouragement and cheering in support of athletes, in a respectful sporting manner. Examples of poor sporting manner include the purposeful wrong calling of arrows, and shouting loudly when an opponent is at full draw. If you feel anyone is behaving in an inappropriate manner, inform either the chair of judges (CoJ), the tournament organiser (TO), or your university's Christie coordinator. Both the CoJ and TO are empowered to ask people to change their behaviour or leave the venue. All competitors must follow the Christie Code of Conduct or risk disciplinary action.
