The Harbour House Archery challenge 2026 consists of eight (8) competitions taken place from **March to September 2026**. Each competition round offers two (2) opportunities for archers to enter.

Competition Format:



To be eligible for the final awards, archers must complete one (1) of each of the following rounds:

- 900 Round.
- Double 720 Round
- 720 round H2Hs
- 1440 Round

Your highest point's scores from each of these four (4) formats will be counted towards your final Harbour House Challenge total. Final standings will be based on these combined best scores points.

Points will be awarded based on the position in each competition starting with

- 1st 100 points
- 2nd 80 points
- 3rd 70 points
- 4th 60 points
- 5th 50 points
- 6th 40 points
- 7th 30 points
- 8th 20 points
- 9th to last place 10 points

Trophies awarded to 1st , 2nd & 3rd places at the category at the end of the challenge in September 2026.
