Longbow men and women	30 m round

## ANNEX

### GOLD GAME

One prize for one shooting group.

Groups remain the same as they were in the qualification round.

1 arrow, 40 seconds per round.

Shooting place is the same as was in the qualification round.

**After the end, don't touch or pull any arrow before the game judge's confirmation!**

1 ROUND. Those who have 8 or more stay in game, all others – eliminated. If only one participant in the group has 8 or more, then he/she becomes the winner. If no one has 8 or more, the group shoots one more round and the closest to the center wins.

2 ROUND. Those who have 9 or more stay in game, all others – eliminated. If only one participant in the group has 9 or more, then he/she becomes the winner. If no one has 9 or more, the group shoots one more round and the closest to the center wins.

3 ROUND. Those who have 10 stay in game, all others – eliminated. If only one participant in the group has 10, then he/she becomes the winner. If no one has 10, the group shoots one more round and the closest to the center wins.

4 ROUND. Those who have X stay in game, all others – eliminated. If only one participant in the group has X, then he/she becomes the winner. If no one has X, the group shoots one more round and the closest to the center wins.

5 ROUND. The remaining participants in the group shoot one last round. Closest to the center wins. If it is impossible to determine the closest to the center, there will be one more shoot off.
