



2026 Home Nations Cup – Outdoor

15th – 16th August 2026

Competitors

A Four Nation competition between selected archers from Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales and a Wildcat England team.

Bowtypes: Barebow; Recurve; Compound

Categories: Women; Open

Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales Representative teams comprise 18 archers selected by the Nations, 3 per category per bowtype plus nominated reserves. Reserves may be invited to fill open spaces in the wildcat England team through a lottery.

The wildcat England team is open for applications by any archer eligible to shoot for England under Commonwealth Games Federation Byelaw 16.3.2 (grandparent/3-year resident). Applicants will need to submit their entry fee and 3x WA720 scores shot after 17th August 2025 at UKRS or equivalent shoots. Where more archers apply than places, highest aggregate submitted score will determine entries. [Apply Here](#)

Format

Day 1

- Qualification WA720 (Recurve 70m, Compound & Barebow 50m)
- Category Team Semi-Final Matches Per Bowtype
- Mixed Team H2H's per Bowtype [paired by qualification ranking]
(1/8 Finals, ¼ Finals, Semi-Finals)

Day 2

- Bronze medal Matches (Mixed & Category Teams)
- Gold medal Matches (Mixed & Category Teams)
- Cup and Medal Presentations

Cup Competition

The overall winners of the Home Nations Cup will be decided on a combination of qualification rounds and team match results.

Each Nation's qualification scores will be totalled per bowtype and category (teams), with the highest ranked team per bowtype and category gaining 4 points for their Nation, 3 for second, 2 for third and 1 for fourth. *Maximum points possible = 24 (6 bt/cat)*

In matches, each team Gold medal is worth 4 points to a Nation, 3 for Silver, 2 for Bronze and 1 for fourth place. *Maximum points possible = 36 (6 teams, 3 mixed)*

The overall winner will be the Nation with the most points. *Maximum possible = 60*

Practical Details

Team Submissions: Nations should submit their teams by Friday 25th July via JustGo (Link will be supplied to Team Managers). Wildcat entries will close at 5pm on Monday 20th July.

Accommodation: En-suite single rooms in Willow Court are available on site at £50 per night 'room only' or £60 per night with breakfast. A limited number of double rooms are available at £90 'room only' or £110 per night with breakfast. Bookings via the link below.

Parking: Parking is available at Willow Court (10 mins walk to the field) and Airthrey Sports Pavilion Car Park. Archers requiring disabled parking will be supplied with detail upon request.

Toilets: Portable toilets will be available on the field, with accessible and general toilets available in the nearby Sports Pavillion.

Refreshments: Lunch will be provided both days. Dietary requirements notified at the time of team submission can be accommodated
