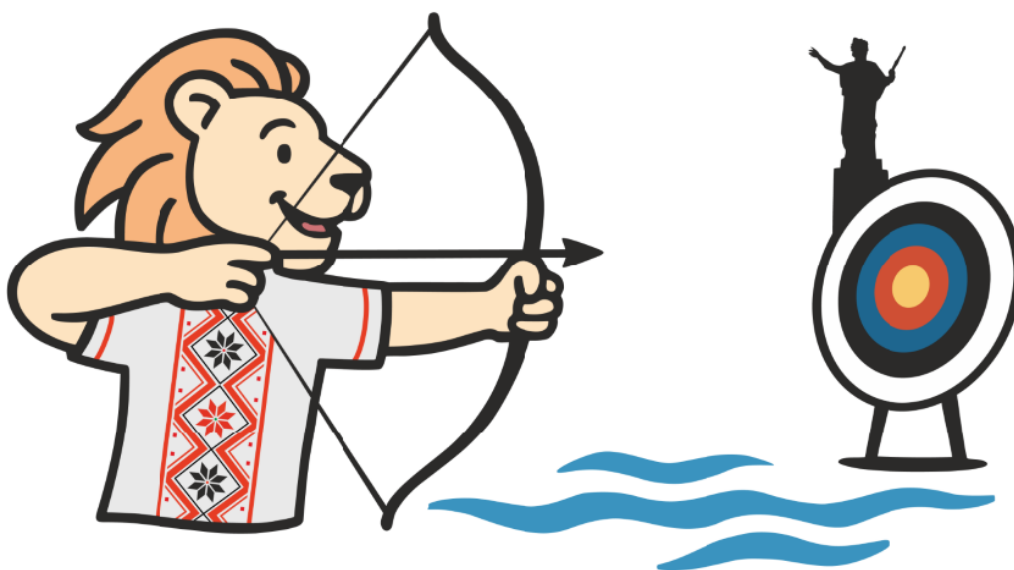

3.2. Practice Field and Competition Field

The practice field is organized on the field next to the competition field in opposite direction.

Competition field is a football field with natural grass. The official practice and all competitions including mixed team finals, team finals and individual finals will be organized on the same, but reorganized field.

The distance between 2 shooting positions on the shooting line will be 0,90 m. All medal matches will be shot alternate and will have live coverage.

Also, some other matches during the competition may have live coverage on internet.

3.3. Competition Program (attached)

The competition program is published. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date/hour it was printed. The latest version of the Competition Schedule at the moment of writing the Team Managers Booklet is V1.0

Warm up will be organized on the competition field as it is scheduled in the attached program. Noncompeting archers will be allowed to practice only on the practice field till Friday.

Practice field will open from 1st till 5th June 2026 8:00-12:00 and 14:00-18:00. Schedule may be modified if necessary.

3.4. Equipment Inspection

Equipment inspection will follow the program of the official practice and will be held at the official practice field. Each team will be called (in the English alphabetical order) and invited by the judges to the dedicated place for the Equipment inspection.

- All team members (archers and officials) shall wear or bring their team uniforms.
- Spare equipment and accreditation cards must also be brought for inspection.
- The judges may conduct spot inspections of the athlete's equipment at any time during the competition.
- The start number will be given at the warmup on the day of competition at shooting line in front of archer's position and will not be changed during the competition.
- The start list will be published before the start of the official practice, so archers can practice on their assigned targets.
- There is no access to the competition field before or without accreditation is done.

The correct spelling of athletes' names, as well as the correct date of birth in the archers' list will be checked during the accreditation – please bring passport or EEA national ID card to the accreditation.

3.5. Qualification Round & Information on scoring

Target assignments will be published only on boards and on internet.

30 seconds per arrow will be the time allowed for individual shooting during Qualification and Elimination Rounds, therefore the time limit for 6 arrows will be 3 minutes.

Shooting in qualifications will be conducted with 3-4 archers per target in AB-CD format.

For the qualification rounds, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. Please instruct the archers to mark the arrow holes during practice.

The athletes will have double scoring from qualification round to individual bronze medal matches and the same is for team and mixed team competition: one electronic and one on paper scorecard. For each target, one athlete will enter the score on the paper score sheet; another athlete will make the electronic scoring.

All the athletes on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered.

Please instruct your athletes to fill in properly the scorecards including total score, 10's and X's and sign the card before handing them back after each round. Double scoring is required (one on paper and one electronic) and after the match also the winner must be marked.

3.6. Ties and Ranking

- Ties

In the event of a tied score, the ranking of the qualification round results will be determined in the following order. Except for those ties as set out in Article 12.5.2. (ties deciding the entrance to the Elimination Rounds, in Matches, or entrance to the top 8), tied scores in all rounds are ranked using:

- Individuals and Teams:
 - The greatest number of Xs (inner 10s).
 - If still tied, the greatest number of 10s.
 - After this, athletes still tied will be declared equal. However, for the position in the match play chart, a disk toss will decide the position of those declared equal.
- The X and 10 is counted separately in the scorecard.
- Ranking

At the completion of the event, all athletes/teams/mixed teams will be individually ranked.

The qualification scores will be considered for the athletes/teams who do not qualify for the elimination rounds. The one-arrow average (rounded up to the third decimal) on the round they lost will be used to rank athletes.

3.7. Arrows Left Behind

Athletes are responsible for ensuring that, following scoring, no arrows are left in the target butts before any signal is given to continue shooting.

- If arrows are accidentally left in the target butt, the shooting will not be interrupted. An athlete may shoot that end with other arrows, provided a judge is informed before shooting begins. The judge will participate in the scoring of that end, making sure that the arrows which have remained in the target butt from the previous end were entered in the athlete's scorecard before any arrows are withdrawn from the target butt.

3.8. Individual Elimination Round

For the elimination rounds, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. So please instruct the archers to mark the arrow holes during practice. Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.

For the individual and team eliminations in compound division the lower centers (shooting positions C and D) of Eleven targets will be used.

We will keep to the starting time at the beginning of the session and then the competition will run as it goes. Therefore, some matches could start sooner than the time indicated in the schedule. Please be aware of this and be prepared for it.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, archers will be allowed to shoot, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed. The individual elimination round will start with:

the 1/48 in categories with more than 56 archers

the 1/24 in categories with 33-56 archers

the 1/16 in categories with 17-32 archers

the 1/8 in categories with 9-16 archers

Please check carefully the schedule.

3.8.1. Recurve

The system will be used for Recurve division. All individual matches will consist of maximum 5 sets of 3 arrows per set. As soon as an athlete reaches 6 set points, the athlete is declared the winner.

3.8.2. Compound

The compound match round will be used for compound division. All matches will consist of 5 ends of 3 arrows, cumulative scoring. At the end of 5 ends, the athlete with the highest total is the winner.

3.8.3. Barebow

The system will be used for Barebow division. All individual matches will consist of maximum 5 sets of 3 arrows per set. As soon as an athlete reaches 6 set points, the athlete is declared the winner.

3.9. Team and Mixed Teams Eliminations and Finals

The Team and Mixed team Elimination Round will start with the 1/8. Bronze and Gold medal matches will be organized with alternating shooting for mixed teams and teams on Friday. Remember that you need an agent for the blind on Friday.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, teams will be allowed to shoot on the competition field, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

Remember that the composition of the mixed team and team can be changed in writing at least 15 minutes before the start of the official practice of that round of competition – see art. 4.3.2. below. The form is attached at the end of this document.

3.9.1. Recurve Team

- Max. 4 sets of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (set points scoring). As soon as a team reaches 5 set points, this team is declared the winner and advances to the next round.

3.9.2. Recurve Mixed Team

- Max. 4 sets of 4 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (set points scoring). As soon as a team reaches 5 set points, this team is declared the winner and advances to the next round.

3.9.3. Compound Team

- 4 ends of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (50 m, cumulative scoring). At the end of four ends, the team with the highest total is the winner.

3.9.4. Compound Mixed Team

- 4 ends of 4 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (50 m, cumulative scoring). At the end of four ends, the team with the highest total is the winner.

3.9.5. Barebow Mixed Team

- Max. 4 sets of 4 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (set points scoring). As soon as a team reaches 5 set points, this team is declared the winner and advances to the next round.

Shoot-off in Team eliminations and Finals with simultaneously shooting is just one arrow each archer, 60 sec per team (40 sec for Mixed Teams). In Bronze and Gold medal matches with alternating shooting the archers are alternating after every single arrow.

3.10.

Individual Finals Round – Bronze and Gold Medal Matches

All Bronze and Gold medal matches individual will have alternate shooting. The field for medal matches will be divided in two areas – the final field and the practice field for finalists.

Remember that you need an agent for the blind.

3.11. Appeal Procedure (Form attached)

An Appeal form is attached to this document (see attached after this chapter, Appendix 3)

In case of Intent to Appeal or an actual Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to his deputy. A fee of 50 EUR must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

The fee will be returned if the appeal is upheld or if the Jury of Appeal decides that it is appropriate.

4) Technical Matters (TD + chairman of Judges)

4.1. Timing Control system

The Chronotir timing equipment will be used for timing with several displays on the competition and practice field.

4.2. Results system

IANSEO is the provider of the results. The scoring in the Qualification and Elimination Round will be done by the archers. One archer will write down the score on the paper score sheet and another archer will score on a terminal. The third/fourth archer verifies that the correct scores are entered.

The terminals are used during the Qualifications, Eliminations and Finals, but not during the bronze and gold medal matches with alternating shooting.

4.3. Rules that apply in this event

4.3.1. Practice on the competition field during byes

Shooting on the competition field during byes, for individuals, will be limited to three arrows per end, the first three sets for recurve and barebow, and five ends for compound. In the case of teams, it will be limited to six arrows for teams and four arrows for mixed teams (2 arrows per athlete) per end, a maximum of three sets for recurve and barebow, and four ends for compound. If more than the mentioned number of arrows are shot by an athlete or a team in an end after being warned by a judge, the athlete or team may be denied further practice on the competition field, but any such violation will not affect the next match.

4.3.2. Team members' nomination

For match play, a team or mixed team will consist of the highest-ranked three (or two if a Mixed Team) athletes from the Qualification Round. In case of a substitution, the team manager will notify the officially approved results verifier or the chairperson of judges, in writing, at least fifteen minutes before the start of official practice of the first match of the match play stage for the event concerned. The substitute athlete must have competed in the Qualification Round. If a substitution is made, medals will only be awarded to the athletes who shot the Team Match Play Round. A violation of the foregoing will result in the disqualification of the team.

4.3.3. Number of team officials

A Team Manager may be helped by other team officials (such as coaches, physiotherapists, psychologists, etc.). There may not be more than one team official on the field of play for each athlete competing at the time. However, the maximum number of team officials on the field of play at the same time is four. This may be increased by one official per category if the Member Association has athletes competing in three or more categories at the same time.

4.3.4. Archers acting as Coaches

Archers may be acting as coaches during finals.

4.3.5. Shoot-offs - Individuals:

A single arrow shoot-off for score.

- If the score is the same, the arrow closest to the centre of the target face will resolve the tie.
- If the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot-offs will be conducted until the tie is resolved.
- If both athletes miss the scoring area of the target, both athletes will shoot an additional arrow.

4.3.6. Shoot-offs - Teams:

A three-arrow (two-arrow for Mixed Team) shoot-off for score, a single arrow by each team member.

- If the score is tied, the team with the arrow closest to the centre will win.
- If still tied, the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre will determine the winner
- If the tie cannot be resolved, successive shoot-offs will be conducted until the tie is resolved.

4.4. Youth Cup rules

4.4.1. Classes admitted

- Under 18 Women (Recurve and Compound)
- Under 18 Men (Recurve and Compound)
- Under 21 Women (Recurve, Compound and Barebow)
- Under 21 Men (Recurve, Compound and Barebow)

4.4.2. Divisions admitted

- Recurve Division with equipment as specified in WA Rules.
- Compound Division with equipment as specified in WA Rules.
- Barebow Division with equipment as specified in WA Rules.

4.4.3. Determining the winners of the European Youth Cup circuit

There will be 3 individual winners determined by the Individual competitions and 3 MAs winners determined by the Team and the Mix Team competitions, in each category.

4.4.4. Determining the winners in the Individual competition

The winner, the second and the third placed archers in each category of the European Youth Cup Circuit will be determined among the WAE athletes by the highest total score of the Qualification rounds results of the two legs.

4.4.5. Determining the winners in the Team and Mixed Team competition

The placement of each team and mixed team in each category at the Qualification round of the two legs will be taken into account. In case that teams outside the WAE MAs are ranked in places 1-4, a separate ranking without those teams will be prepared to award points only to WAE teams. The number of points from the two legs will be added.

4.4.6. The following points are being given at each leg for teams and mixed teams placed after the Qualification round:

- 1st place 10 points
- 2nd place 8 points
- 3rd place 6 points
- 4th place 4 points
- And for lower ranking 1 point

4.4.7. Rankings

After the end of this event, the Youth Cup Ranking will be prepared and the results obtained during the European Youth Championships in Rome (ITA) will be added to those obtained in Ruse.

The awarding of the Youth Cup circuit 2026 will take place in Rome (ITA) immediately after the awarding of the competition.

4.5. Dress Instructions

Athletes, officials and staff should have a proper appearance when they are on the field during competition. Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national team uniforms (with same look per division following WA rules) and sport shoes.

Open shoes are not allowed on the field of play and on practice field.

We would like to remind all teams that names of archers and country codes are appreciated for this event, but mandatory for archers participating in major events.

4.6. Lost arrows

All lost and found arrows are to be reported to judges. An arrow found on the field of play at later stage of the competition will be considered as a part of that end if not reported.

It is very important to report lost arrows because we are on a football field, and any arrow left in the field can cause serious injuries to football athletes.

5) Logistical Aspects (OC)

5.1. Transportation:

Daily transportation schedule will be published separately.

5.2. Bow and equipment storage

The stadium's main building contains dedicated rooms for storing bows and bow cases, equipped with racks. Access to this area is the same as for the restrooms. We strongly encourage you to make use of the bow storage facilities.

5.3. Meals

All meals, breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served at the hotels according to the schedule: breakfast: 07:00-09:00, lunch: 12:00-14:00, dinner: 18:30-21:00; if necessary, the serving time can be modified.

Water will be served at lunch and dinner while the other drinks ordered must be paid for.

5.4. Accreditation Cards rules

The accreditation card must be worn at all times in the practice and competition areas.

6) Protocol and ceremonies (OC)

6.1. Opening

There is no opening ceremony. Only a short welcome speech will be organized before the start of official practice for each session.

6.2. Medal Ceremonies and Closing Ceremony

Medal ceremonies will be conducted separately for teams and individuals.

All archers involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point ASAP to proceed quickly and smoothly with the award ceremony.

After awarding the medalists need to stay on the field for the picture. All teams are kindly asked to stay on the field till the end of the medal ceremony.

There will be short closing ceremony. The event will finish officially after the last medal ceremony at the final's venue.

6.3. Disco party

Disco party will be organized after the dinner in Hotel Cosmopolitan, 21:00-23:30 on 6th June 2026. According to the laws in Bulgaria for under 18, only non-alcoholic drinks will be served for all participants. Small snacks will be served.

7) Medical Related issues (Medical representative)

There is a doctor responsible for First Aid in the field. Ambulance will be available on the field of play during competing hours.

In case of emergency during your stay in the hotel, please inform the reception and proper arrangements will be made.

8) Doping Control

8.1. Doping control

There will be no doping control on this event. Anyway, it is an official event, and external doping control is possible.

8.2. Alcohol test

Level of alcohol will not be tested during the competition.

9) Other matters of importance (WAE TD)

9.1. The environment

We ask you to instruct your athletes to use the litter bins which are placed behind the waiting area.

9.2. Water

Every participant will receive as a present a bottle/cup. It is important to mention that the tap water in Ruse is drinkable, clean and fresh. The bottle can be filled with water anywhere in the hotel as well as also on the field. Bottles can be also exchanged empty for full on the FOP.

9.3. No smoking and no alcohol

This is a non-smoking event for the practice and official competition areas. Inside sport area you are not allowed to smoke, you must use the designated areas outside the sport field. The same is valid also for electronic cigarettes.

Also, alcohol consumption is forbidden.

9.4. Information System

- Due to environmental preservation and responsible behavior toward nature we will not have any printed material.
- Printed documents will be published only on the board at the competition venue.

9.5. Lost items
