Recurve (including Longbow)

- 70m on a 122cm face
- Longbow archers will compete alongside recurve archers in the Head-to-Head phase

Barebow

- 50m on a 122cm face

Compound

- 50m on a six-ring 80cm face

- 90m / 70m / 50m / 30m 36 arrows at each distance

Women

- 70m / 60m / 50m / 30m 36 arrows at each distance

For the second six dozen:

- Recurve and Compound will shoot on six-ring 80cm faces
- Barebow and Longbow will shoot on full 80cm faces

Please note:

- No junior rounds or 50+ rounds are offered.
 - Archers aged 50+ may choose to shoot the Women's WA1440 (70m maximum distance) but will not be eligible for awards in that category.
 - Juniors are welcome to enter but must shoot the adult round for their bowstyle.

Archery GB Membership

All competitors must present a valid Archery GB membership card or proof of current membership at registration.

Archery GB Competition Categories

This tournament will operate under the Archery GB competition category policy effective from October 2025.

Female Category

- Open to competitors recorded female at birth.

Open Category

- Open to all archers, including those recorded male at birth, those recorded female at birth, and those identifying as transgender or non-binary.

Drug Testing

As a World Record Status event, competitors may be subject to drug testing.

Any competitor selected for testing must comply. Refusal to provide a sample will be treated as a positive result.

Parents or guardians of junior competitors must confirm consent for testing should a junior be selected.

Catering

A BBQ serving breakfast and lunch will be available throughout the weekend, including vegetarian options.

Cash and card payments accepted.

Accessibility

Guildford Archery Club is proud of its award-winning accessibility facilities, including:

- Designated disabled parking
- Solid-surface access route to the shooting line
- Sheltered rest area adjacent to the shooting line
- Accessible toilet facilities within the clubhouse
- Level access from the car park

Vehicles will generally be parked approximately 80 metres from the shooting line.

Please contact the organiser in advance if you have specific accessibility requirements.

Smoking and Vaping

Smoking and the use of electronic cigarettes are permitted only in designated areas at least 5 metres behind the tent line.

Targets

Competitors will shoot on TenZone layered foam bosses.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome on the field but must remain on a lead at all times.

Parking

Ample parking is available on site.

Please park considerately and avoid blocking other vehicles, as some competitors may need to leave before shooting concludes.

Please do not use the Normandy Village Hall car park.

Trophy Return

Previous trophy winners are responsible for returning trophies before shooting begins. Trophies should be cleaned and engraved before return.

Photography

By entering this tournament, competitors agree that photographs and video footage may be taken during the event.

Guildford Archery Club may use images for reporting on the event and promoting future activities.

Anyone with concerns regarding photography should contact the Tournament Organiser.

Photographers are reminded that images should not be published online without the permission of those featured.
