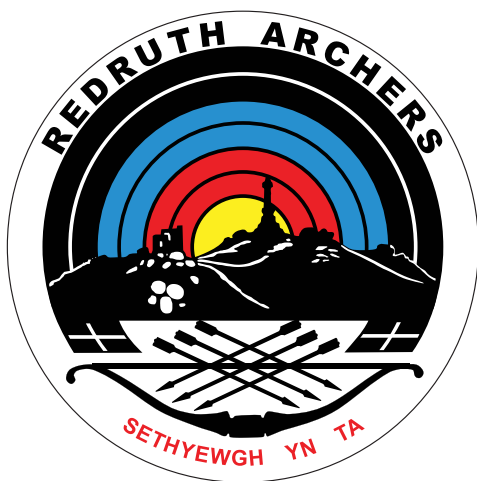

Camping

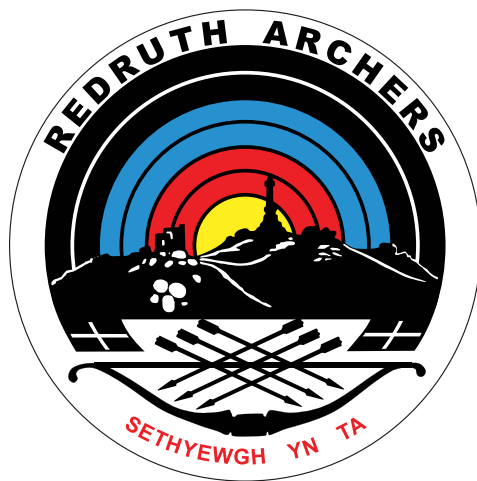
Camping available on the second field for £5.00 per night. Breakfast will also be available, please prebook camping and breakfast online with your tournament entries.
