Round/Format

- Both days: WA 24 3D round
- Available for: Compound Unlimited, Compound Barebow, Recurve, Barebow, Traditional, AFB, Longbow, Asiatic.

Entry Information

Fee: £45 (adults), £30 (juniors)

- There are no single day entries available.
- The entry fee less 20% will be refunded for cancellations before Saturday 27 June.
- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.
- Juniors wishing to compete for the adult titles must enter in the appropriate adult category and pay the adult fee.

Priority entry and invitation

- Pre-invitation will be sent on Monday 20 April to the following archers:
- Top 3 in each category of the 2025 UK 3D rankings.
- Any athlete who competed at the 2025 World 3D Championships, but is not currently placed in a top 3 in the 2025 UK 3D ranking.

Event timings (both days)

- Practice butts available from 8:00 am
- Registration and equipment inspection from 8:30 am
- Assembly at 10:00 am

Prizes

- UK 3D Archery Championship medals will be awarded to the highest placed archers holding, or eligible to hold, a British passport.
- Medals will be awarded in all WA recognised categories according to the number of entries. 2 – 3 entries = gold medal. 4 – 7 entries = gold and silver medals, 8 or more entries = gold, silver and bronze medals.
- UK 3D Archery Championship medals will also be awarded to non-WA recognized categories according to the number of entries, as above.
- 50+ medals will be awarded to those who enter 50+ only.
