Location: Cleve Archers, Down Yonder, Moorend, Hambrook, BS16 6JA
Note: Cleve Archers is situated next to a no through road. You must approach from the Avon Ring Road A4174 along Bromley Heath Road to avoid a 20 minute detour.

WA Round: **Single WA 720 Round 2 Sessions – single detail**

Morning and Afternoon Sessions: World Record Status WA 720 ranking round with 72 arrows shot at a single distance on 122cm faces, 70m recurve/Longbow, 60m recurve/Longbow and 50m compound/barebow. Compound targets will have one 6-ring face per archer, whilst all other targets will have one 10-ring face per target.

VI Metric Round: **VI WA 30m Round 2 Sessions – single detail**

Visually Impaired (VI) metric outdoor target archery round, consisting of 72 arrows shot at a distance of 30 meters on an 80cm target face.

Metric Round: **Single Metric Rounds 2 Sessions – single detail**

Morning and Afternoon Sessions: UK Record Status rounds at the following distances: Metric 122-50, Metric 122-40, Metric 122-30
Will consist of 72 arrows shot at a single distance on a 122cm 10 zone target face for recurve & longbow, and an 80cm 10 zone face for compound.

Limitation Over 50's and under 21's are welcome to take part but there are no separate categories.

Registration: Registration will be open from 8.00 am. Membership cards will be required for booking in. If you are not yet in possession of a valid card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to Archery GB.

Para Classification: Official Para Category: Or Self-Declared:

Event Timings: Equipment inspection: from 08:00 am and 12.00 pm. Will be announced by the judges.

Session 1 Assembly at 9.10 am Practice at 9.20 am Practice ends at 9:50 am

Session 2 Assembly at 12.45 pm Practice at 1.00 pm Practice ends at 1:30 pm

Event Format: There will be 2 archers per boss, shooting in 1 detail. Shooting will be in timed 6 arrow ends of 4 minutes

Awards: Gold Medals will be awarded for all categories, Gold and Silver medals will be awarded for categories with three or more entrants and Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in categories with six or more entrants.

Dress: Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations. Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting 307 for dress regulations.

Drug Testing: Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable to drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering the tournament Parents / Guardians are giving consent for junior archers (under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.

- Refreshments:** Hot & cold drinks and a selection of cakes available all day
- Lost Arrows:** Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow).
It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.
- Photography:** People wishing to take photographs during the tournament must register their details with the Tournament Organiser.
If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child / young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the Tournament Organisers.
- Special Requirements:** Please ensure that the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have - please don't assume we already know.
Archers who are unable to get to the target should discuss their specific requirements with the Tournament Organiser. It would be appreciated if archers could provide their own agent where possible.

M5/M32

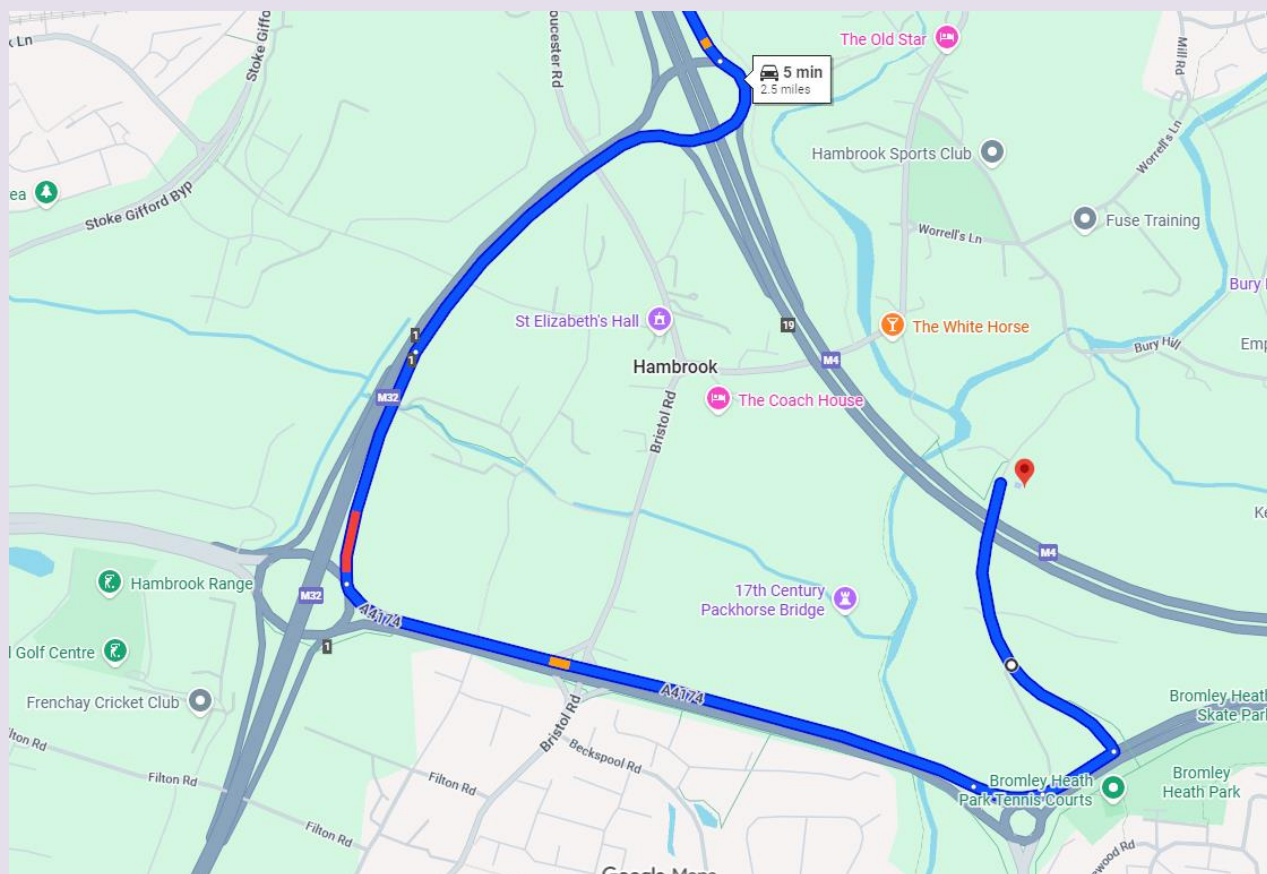
The ground is just 5 minutes off the M32 Motorway, junction 19. Follow the A4174 signposted Kingswood.
