Rounds: **WRS** Double WA1440 and Metrics

Age Categories: Ladies: 50+, Senior, Under 21
Gentlemen: 50+, Senior, Under 21

Bow Styles: Asiatic, Barebow, Compound, Crossbow, Longbow, Recurve

Format: Full 10 ring targets at all distances

Shooting Procedure: Two details, (AGB Method 2). **Ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes, morning distances, (two longest distances)**
Ends of 3 arrows in 2 minutes, afternoon distances, (two shortest distances)

Rules: ArcheryGB [Rules of Shooting](#) and ArcheryGB dress regulations, Rule 307 **WILL** apply

Drug Testing: Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply.
Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.
Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached
